



Dear Parents/Legal Guardians,

Thank you for your interest in Camp Bon Coeur. Although Camp Bon Coeur attempts to help families pay for the camp fee, there is no guarantee we can find sponsors for all applicants. To help with presentations, we have new camp brochures. Please contact us if you are interested in using them. The following are suggestions of possible sources you can contact:

1. **Community service organizations** such as your church group, Junior League, the Independent Physicians Alliance, Knights of Columbus, Kiwanis Clubs, Lions Club, Mended Hearts group (call your pediatric cardiologist or local hospital for a contact person), United Way, or youth groups.
2. Contributions made to camp can be designated to a particular camper. For example, contact your local newspaper or TV station and share your child's story and his/her desire to go to camp. A fund can be set up for readers/viewers to send contributions to **"Your Child's Camp Scholarship Fund"** in care of Camp Bon Coeur. The office staff will help you contact your local media. Call Susannah Craig at (337) 233-8437.
3. Ask your employer about **matching funds**. If you contribute to a nonprofit organization, some employers will match funds.

Remember, all donations to Camp Bon Coeur are tax deductible.

Also, you must notify the office before you use Camp Bon Coeur's name in any media story or fundraising event.
